Pro Tips for Middle School Scheduling...

Elective choices can contribute to your High School Graduation Plan requirements and provide more options while in High School.

7th Grade

- *Computer Science for Innovators and Makers (CTE .5 credit)
- *Fundamentals of Computer Science (CTE 1 HS credit)

8th Grade

- *Language other than English (2 credits are needed by graduation)
- *Algebra may be taken in 8th grade for HS credit in the Math slot above.

Any of these requirements not met in Middle School will need to be scheduled in High School.

Pro tips for High School Scheduling....

Some extra elective spots may be available from High School credit classes taken while in Middle School.

Required classes for High School

2 Language classes other than English (one may be earned in MS)

PE - one credit

CTE - one credit

Speech - .5 credit (only class of '22 and '23)

These classes can be scheduled in any of the Elective periods above at any grade level

The schedule above will give you 2 endorsements on your transcript at graduation. Multi-disciplinary and Arts and Humanities. Any other endorsements can be earned utilizing the elective spots above

FAQ'S

I'm already participating in a sport or different extracurricular activity. Can I still join choir?

YES, we have several students each year the participate in multiple activities.

Do all ensembles get to compete and travel?

All our ensembles have an opportunity to travel and compete in local festivals.

However, the High School level Choirs have the option to compete on both the state and national level

I don't think I can sing and I can't read music. Is there still a place for me in choir?

YES, all of our students come to us at various levels of musicianship. But, one thing in common with us all...we all started at the beginning!

When can I join the Choir? Are there auditions?

Anyone may join the Aledo Choirs anytime throughout the year (as long as your schedule permits)! However, some of our more advanced Choirs are by audition only. Those auditions are only held at scheduled times at the end of each year.
